



H Roe Bartle Scout Reservation 100th Anniversary Heritage Award

Scouts and leaders may earn this award, while at camp during their session, by completing 3 of the 4 projects in each of the 5 different categories below. Turn in the record sheet at the Osage River Trading Company to pick up your patches.

The History of H Roe Bartle Scout Reservation:

1. Visit Judge Kirkland's cabin.
2. Visit the Lone Star Nature Lodge.
3. Visit Ernie Modlin's cabin.
4. Invite an "old timer" (someone who camped at HRB over 40 years ago) to tell stories to your patrol or troop.

Wildlife On The Reservation:

1. Identify 10 different varieties of trees.
2. Identify by observation 10 different species of birds.
3. Identify by observation 5 different mammals.
4. Identify 12 different constellations, stars or planets.

Outdoor Skills And Contests:

1. Tie each of the knots required for Scout, Tenderfoot and First Class Ranks.
2. Show three ways to start fire without matches (magnifying glass, hot spark, flint and steel, live coal, etc).
3. Make a useful camp gadget with lashings.
4. Play chess or checkers with a friend.

Service To Camp:

1. Complete a campsite conservation project.
2. Complete a camp clean up project with your troop or patrol.
3. Participate in an Outpost program.
4. Participate in a patrol activity.

Camp Fellowship:

1. Participate in a fellowship campfire with another troop.
2. Participate in a campsite flag ceremony.
3. Talk to a Scout from another state and find out about his troop's activities.
4. Teach a skill to another Scout.
