## **WHAT**

In keeping with the Trailhead District Camporee theme, **Extreme Scouting**, a number of challenging sporting and skill-related activities will be constructed to test all Scouts and Scouters.

### **Scout Program Activities**

**Water Rocketry**-Launch air/water powered rockets at targets for accuracy.

**"Old Misery" Log**-Carry a log to a ravine and get all scouts across safely.

**Extreme First Aid Carry**-Patrol gets injured Scout through a course using various First Aid carry methods.

**Extreme Bowling**-Bowling, but with an outdoor twist.

**All Out "Dragster" Racing**-Pull a scout on a flat sled down a long grass drag strip.

**Naval Artillery**-Launch water balloons from shore at a menacing boat on the lake.

**Extreme Sack Race**-5 man sack race... walk, drag or crawl to the finish line.

## Patrol Gear

- 2 Compasses per patrol – they will not be supplied
- Clip Boards for Patrol Leaders
- Ink Pens (No Pencils)
- Food – District will not provide any food.
- Patrol Flag – you might need it.
- Fire safety bucket.
