What to take to Camp

Prior to attending camp all Scouts and Adults should have submitted their up-to-date health forms, medication sheets / medications, signed summer camp contracts and full fee payments as appropriate. Please review this list carefully. All clothing and equipment should be clearly marked with the Scout's name and troop number.

Clothing & Equipment (daily wear, 9 days)

- 12" x 12" x 21" Camp box with a lock
- Swim trunks (wear under uniform on Day 1)
- Boy Scout Handbook (preferably with a cover)
- Poncho / Rain Gear
- Camp t-shirt (available at camp trading post) and a troop t-shirt (Class B)
- 5-9 pairs of socks
- Hiking shoes & tennis shoes (inexpensive)
- Extra underwear & t-shirts
- Hat or cap
- Sweater or light jacket
- Jeans or other long pants
- Short pants
- Handkerchiefs
- Bath towel & toiletries (soap, toothbrush / paste, comb, etc.)
- Flashlight (extra batteries)
- Sleeping bag or 3 blankets; pillow
- Mosquito / Bug repellent (non-aerosol)
- Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- Canteen or water bottle
- Backpack & cook kit (if participating in overnight Outpost programs)

- Notebook paper, pencil & pen, prerequisite merit badge materials
- Bible or prayer book

Scout Uniform (Adults and Scouts Class "A", Day 1)

- Official Scout shorts
- Official Short sleeved Scout shirt
- Official Scout belt
- Official Scout socks (green w/red trim)
- Neckerchief and tie slide

Optional Equipment

- Sneakers / Moccasins
- Sewing kit
- Camera & Film
- Pocket Knife (Tot N Chip Card)
- Sunglasses
- Small rug / mat for tent
- Work gloves
- Nylon line, clothes pins, coat hanger(s)
- Camp stool (no back unless a Life Scout)
- Shower / water shoes
- Stationery

Do Not Bring The Following Items

- Sheath knives or any knife longer than 3"
- Electronics – radios, game boys, CD players, cell phones, etc.
- Magic card decks
- Fire making materials including matches or lighters. When needed these will be supplied.
- Clothing with alcohol, tobacco, adult or other inappropriate logos or themes
- Valuables (other than a small amount of spending money)
- Hammocks or other devices that require hanging from camp trees or facilities
- Flip flops, sandals, or other open toed shoes
