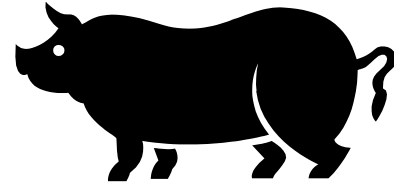




Drexel Hog Farm & Shootout



When: May 18th – 20th 2012

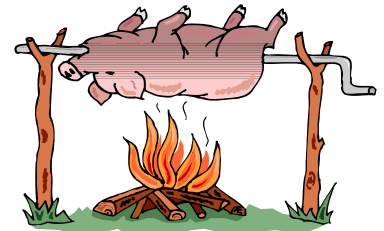
Where: Phillips Family Farm

Equipment:

Primitive Camping – Trowel and Cat Holes.
We will be shooting 20 and 12 gauge shotguns. The troop will provide clay pigeons and shells. If you want to bring your own gun you need to make special arrangements with Mr. Russell.

Drivers: 50 minute drive. Head South on US-69; Go 30 miles - Take 359th Street Exit and turn LEFT (East) onto west 359th Street; Go approx. 4 miles and continue onto Ethel Street; Go .2 miles and turn left (North) onto 2nd Street; Go .7 miles and continue onto N. Holmes Road; Go .4 miles and turn right (East) onto E. 347th St.; Go 3.6 miles – Destination will be on the left: 6100 State Highway A, Drexel, MO 64742
